

The board recognizes that worthy and appropriate educational values accrue from student participation in civic and community affairs. As such, the board encourages the use of students for public performances when such performances contribute to the educational processes and objectives of the school district, and when it does not unduly interfere with the students' educational program.

1. All performances shall be approved by the immediate administrator involved.
2. The extended use of one particular group should be discouraged.
3. Extensive travel by a particular group should be discouraged.
4. Student groups below the senior high level should engaged in only limited activity.
