The board will consider the acceptance of memorial scholarships in honor of persons who have special significance to the students, the school district or the community. A room or item may be named for the person in whose honor the scholarship is created.

Building principals may receive pieces of educational equipment or materials for an attendance center as a memorial to a student or person having a special significance to the students of that school. Items received as memorials become the property of the school district. Principals must have the superintendent's approval to accept any item that may require additional maintenance cost to the school district. The superintendent may establish guidelines for the acceptance of such memorials.

Dedication and naming of permanent structures, or parts thereof, or property upon which they exist, to recognize any individual or groups or dedicated to the memory of any individual or group, must receive unanimous approval of the board.

The superintendent may receive the following in the name of the school district after receiving unanimous approval of the board:

- 1) Pieces of educational equipment or materials bearing advertising or the name of an individual, group or business.
- 2) Pieces of athletic equipment or materials bearing advertising or the name of an individual, group or business.
- 3) Permanent structures or parts thereof or property upon which they exist bearing advertising or the name of an individual, group or business.
- 4) Monetary donations in return for posted advertising of the name of an individual, group or business. The board shall set a limit for the length of time the advertising will be displayed. This limit shall be set on an individual case-by-case basis.

Items received bearing advertising or the name of an individual, group or business shall become the property of the school district.

The school district has established a Monticello School Foundation Perpetual Fund which provides a fund for monetary donations and memorials in recognition of a particular individual or group.
