

School elections take place biennially on the second Tuesday in September of each odd numbered year. Each biennial school election is used to elect citizens to the board to maintain a five member board and to address other questions that must be submitted to the voters.

Citizens of the school district community seeking a seat on the board must file their nomination papers with the board secretary, or the board secretary's designee, consistent with the deadlines provided in Iowa law.

If a vacancy occurs on the board it may be filled by appointment consistent with Iowa law. If the board does not fill the vacancy by appointment, the board secretary will call a special election to fill the vacancy. Candidates for a seat created by a vacancy must file their nomination papers consistent with the deadlines provided in Iowa law.

All elections will be held as provided in Iowa law. It is the responsibility of the county commissioner of elections to conduct school elections.
