

Students who are eligible to attend an Iowa public school but who are not legal residents of this district may be admitted to school at the discretion of the superintendent upon application and payment of tuition. The tuition rate shall be the current per pupil cost of the district as computed by the board secretary and as authorized by the State Department of Education.

Resident students whose families move from the district after the start of semester, and who wish to complete the semester in the district, may be permitted to attend without the payment of tuition at the discretion of the superintendent. These students, other than students in grades eleven and twelve, must have the recommendation of the principal and identify a resident guardian for purposes of administration.

Students in grades eleven (11) or twelve (12) who are no longer residents of the district, but were residents in the preceding school year, may continue to attend school until they graduate without the payment of tuition. These students must have a resident guardian identified for purposes of administration.

Non-resident students who are eligible to attend an Iowa public school and who have evidence they will become legal residents of the district prior to October 1 may be allowed to attend without the payment of tuition.
