Policy Title: School District Bus Routes Policy #702.10

The board has sole discretion to determine the school bus routes for the school district. The board will review the school bus routes as deemed necessary by the superintendent in conjunction with input from the director of transportation.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to develop the school bus routes keeping in mind the safety of the students, the size of the school buses, the length of the route, the cost to the school district, and other factors as deemed relevant by the board or the superintendent. The superintendent shall also develop emergency school bus routes that may be necessary due to weather or other conditions.

The school district is required to provide a certain level of transportation service to its resident students. The board has complete discretion to provide additional transportation service to its resident and other students.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to make a recommendation as to whether a school vehicle will make a discretionary stop. In making this recommendation, the superintendent shall consider the safety of the students, the size of the school buses, the length of the route, the cost to the school district and other factors as deemed relevant by the board or the superintendent. Changes in bus routes for discretionary stops must be reviewed and approved by the board.
