### COURSES AVAILABLE FOR 5TH-8TH GRADERS: STUDENTS WILL ATTEND ONE COURSE

#### Intro to Machine Sewing

Do you have a creative side? Come explore the art of quilting. In this class you will learn the basics of machine sewing. You will learn how to put together an easy quilting project that you will be able to keep. Beginners are welcome as we explore fabric selection, quilt design and the process of machine sewing a top, layering, and binding a small quilting project. This is a fun class for those that are interested in learning something new and sometimes challenging. Inst: Boheman

#### Programming Apps for Android

Introduction to coding using MIT App Inventor to learn the basics of programming apps for Android devices. App Inventor is a free, cloudbased service that is accessed using a web browser. Students log in with a Google account. The class will start with a simple Talk to Me app, then Ball Bounce- a simple game app and Digital Doodle- a drawing app. These basic apps can also be taken to the next level as time permits. #### Crime Scene Investigators

In this class you will solve the crime! Students will learn how to collect and analyze finger prints and blood spatter. We will also learn how to use a microscope to look at hair collected at a crime scene and how DNA evidence is used to solve a crime. In conclusion, we will be introduced to careers related to this field. Inst: Stadtmueller

#### One Day Only– Introduction to Welding Art (Special Pricing \$35)

Make sparks fly this summer. Learn to cut and weld steel using a wire welder, cutting torch and plasma cutters just like the pros. Take your project home and show your friends and parents.
