2014-2015 James B. Morris Scholarship Application

APPLICATION INFO:

The James B. Morris Scholarship Fund (MSF) provides financial assistance, motivation and internship opportunities for minority students pursuing post-secondary and graduate degrees. The MSF provides this assistance to high-achieving individuals who demonstrate strong academic performance, community service and a need for financial aid.

Within their scholarship process, the MSF also facilitates some named scholarships that have specific criteria. Those named scholarships are:

EMC Insurance Co. Scholarship – These scholarships focus on high-achieving minority high school seniors who will be graduating from an Iowa high school. There are no restrictions on the college major or choice of college. Previous EMC Insurance Companies Scholars are eligible to re-apply for renewed awards throughout their college careers, but will be judged against new applicants. EMC Insurance Companies currently funds five (5) such scholarships annually.

Anne C. Chapman Scholarship – This scholarship is in memorial of Ann M. Chapman, wife of MSF founder, Vincent Chapman, Sr. This scholarship will ideally benefit students in the field of nursing, including public administration.

Vincent C. Chapman, Sr. Scholarship – This scholarship is a "founder's scholarship," and is in memory of MSF founder, Vincent Chapman, Sr. This scholarship is to be given to highly motivated and performing students ideally majoring in the areas of business, finance, and/or public policy.

Brittany Hall Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship is named in memory of Brittany Hall and was created to honor the value that Brittany placed on her college education. This scholarship will ideally benefit a female minority student who is an Iowa resident and attending a college or university in the state of Iowa. Special consideration will be given to applicants that are challenged by learning disabilities or a chronic illness.

Wells Fargo Scholarship – This scholarship is for high performing minority high school seniors who will be graduating from an Iowa high school or college students majoring in the areas of accounting, economics, finance, management or marketing. There are no restrictions on choice of college.

Chrysalis Scholarship – This scholarship is offered to young women who have participated in Chrysalis After-School programs (elementary, middle, or high school) and will be graduating from high school and is planning to attend, or currently attending, a college or university in the state of Iowa.

CRITERIA FOR THE 2015 APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Official high school transcripts (graduating high school seniors **ONLY**)
- 2. Official college transcripts (most recent semester only)
- 3. Two or more letters of reference (at least one must be from an instructor)

- 4. Submit an essay about yourself, why you are applying, must include school and community activities or organizations you are involved in, and your future career plans (minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 500 words).
- 5. Completed application form
- 6. Recent photograph (Head & Shoulder Shot only) Required for press release

NOTE: The Scholarship committee will not accept "SELFIE" photos. The picture size should be 1M and only .bmp and .jpg file types.
