- How the Iowa College Access Network (ICAN) helped prepare them for their post-high school endeavors.
- Describe how their school counselor promoted a culture of college and career readiness at their school.
- The school counselor must be mentioned by name, and examples of school counseling excellence and a positive perception of a college-going culture should be provided.
