Jones County 4-H Scholarships

Awards:

- one \$700 scholarship
- one \$500 scholarship
- two \$250 scholarships
- 1. at least three scholarships will be awarded based on 4-H participation
- 2. at least one scholarship will be awarded as a Livestock/Animal Exhibitor Scholarship which can be either \$250 or \$500 depending on the overall ranking of the candidates
- 3. one 4-H Leadership and Community Service Scholarship (\$700) will be awarded based on a 4-H member's leadership and community service experience

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating senior in high school.
- 2. Applicant must be an active member of a Jones County 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Qualified FFA members are only eligible for the Livestock/Animal Exhibitor Scholarship(s).
- 3. Applicants must be entering professions or vocations requiring a minimum of 6 months of college or career school.

Application components:

- 1. Jones County 4-H Scholarship Application Form
- Additional application form(s) and supplement page(s) as needed:
 Jones County 4-H/FFA Livestock Exhibitor Scholarship Application Supplement
 Jones County 4-H Leadership and Community Service Scholarship Application Supplement
- 3. Two letters of Reference
 - one from a present or past 4-H club leader/FFA chapter advisor
 - one from another person other than a family member (academic advisor, teacher, minister, employer, etc.)
- 4. There WILL be personal interviews of the candidates this year.

Procedures:

Application and letters of reference must be returned by February 20, 2017 to the Jones County Extension & Outreach office, 800 N. Maple Street, Ste. 2, PO Box 28, Monticello, IA 52310.

- 1. Written applications and supplemental materials will be evaluated and scored prior to oral interviews.
 - a. candidates that wish to be considered for the 4-H/FFA Livestock/Animal Exhibitor Scholarship or 4-H Leadership and Community Service Scholarship must complete and attach the respective application supplement form
- 2. Oral interviews will be conducted with the candidates at a designated date/time and scored.
- 3. Total overall scores (from submitted written materials and oral interviews) will be tabulated for each candidate, and candidates will be ranked according to their overall scores.
- 4. Scholarships must be used within one year of the presentation. The actual scholarship funds will be paid to the recipient upon presenting proof (grade transcript, tuition receipt, etc.) of completion of at least one semester of full-time college/career school enrollment following high school graduation (minimum of six months).
