To the Student and Parents:

Please sue this form to apply for a Monticello Education Association (MEA)/Keith Lubbock Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is provided each year by the active members of the MEA in memory of Keith Lubbock. Keith was a science teacher at Monticello, who was killed in a car accident in 1972. Keith was a dedicated professional and well-liked by all who knew him.

The current value of this scholarship varies. Scholarships are awarded at an appropriate ceremony at the school and presented by the MEA President or his/her designee. Additional information about the scholarship is as follows:

- 1. Scholarship selection will be made by a representative committee of the MEA. No committee member can be related to any of the applicants.
- 2. The scholarship winner will be selected based upon the student's scholastic achievement, intellectual ability, character and promise of future contribution to society. Need will be a determining factor only in case of a tie in the selection of the recipient. Since scholastic achievement is the principle consideration in awarding this scholarship, applicants must have earned a composite score of no less than 20 on the American Testing Program (ACT). Preference will be given to those going into education.
- 3. Selection of the recipient will be made without discrimination as to the applicant's race, sex, creed, country of origin or relationship with the MEA. (This specifically means that an MEA member's child may be considered for this award but the parent may not be on the selection committee as mentioned above.)
- 4. The recipient may attend any accredited two or four-year bachelor degree granting college or university in the United States and take such courses of student as he/she chooses.
- 5. Scholarship proceeds will be paid to the recipient upon successful completion of his/her first semester of study. The scholarship winner must send a notarized copy of the student's grade transcript to the treasurer of the MEA before the check can be awarded.
- 6. The scholarship will lapse if the recipient:
 - a. Fails to enroll during the year in which the scholarship is awarded in a course of study meeting the requirements of paragraph 4 above.
 - b. Fails to complete the first semester as outlined in paragraph 5 above.
 - c. Fails to maintain satisfactory scholastic standards consistent with the ability and course of study of the recipient. A minimum average of 2.5 (4 point system) for the first year is required.
- 7. If the recipient is not eligible to receive the award or does not make claim to the award within twelve months of the award date, the award will be rescinded and no award will be given.
