2017-18 AEGON/Transamerica Foundation Kirkwood Scholarships For Students with Disabilities

What is the AEGON/Transamerica Foundation Kirkwood Scholarship?

Grant Wood AEA (GWAEA) administers this \$650 scholarship for students with disabilities (have a current IEP) who attend/attended a high school within the GWAEA service area* and will attend/attend Kirkwood Community College (KCC). Two scholarships each year are made available through the generosity of the AEGON/Transamerica Foundation. Scholarship recipients will have \$325 deposited into a KCC account in their name in the fall. An additional \$325 will be deposited in the spring semester if the student receives passing grades in the fall on nine or more credits.

*The GWAEA service area includes high schools in Alburnett, Anamosa, Belle Plaine, Benton Community, Cedar Rapids, Center Point-Urbana, Central City, Clear Creek Amana, College Community, English Valleys, Highland, HLV, Iowa City, Iowa Valley, Linn-Mar, Lisbon, Lone Tree, Marion, Midland, Mid-Prairie, Monticello, Mount Vernon, North Cedar, North Linn, Olin, Solon, Springville, Tipton, Vinton Shellsburg, West Branch, Washington, and Williamsburg.

Who May Apply

- Seniors with IEPs attending a high school within GWAEA who plan to attend KCC in the fall of 2017, or
- *KCC students currently enrolled in VITAL* who plan to continue at KCC after exiting the VITAL program.

How to Apply

Each applicant for the AEGON/Transamerica KCC scholarship must submit the following:

- 1. *The completed application form* (below). Forms may be hand printed, but *typing is preferred*.
- 2. A typed, one-page letter from the student describing his or her:
 - *Career goal,* how and why this goal was selected and what they've done to prepare for this career;
 - Planned major/course of study at Kirkwood and how a KCC education will help reach those goals;
 - Why they need a college scholarship and how it will help them pursue their dreams; and
 - A description of a challenge or obstacle that the student faced and what he or she did to overcome it.
- 3. Applicants must *attach two (2) letters of recommendation*. At least one letter must be from an educator (teacher, counselor, or school administrator) who knows the student well. The second letter could be from an educator, employer or other non-family member. The letters should address:
 - How long and under what circumstances has the writer known the student;
 - Academic or work qualities of the applicant—has the student taken coursework that will prepare him/her for success at Kirkwood? Has the student had regular attendance? What kind of an employee has the student been?;
 - *Personal qualities* of the student (if from either an educator or employer/other), things like the student's work ethic, attitude toward studies or work, classmates/co-workers/staff, and attendance/punctuality; and
 - *Reasons why* the writer feels the student should be awarded this scholarship, including how the student has dealt with challenges or obstacles.
- 4. *All applicants* must attach a *high school transcript* showing cumulative grade point average (GPA).

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- 5. VITAL program applicants must also attach a Kirkwood transcript showing GPA.
- 6. An official high-school attendance record for the current school year; or, if attending VITAL, a completed VITAL attendance form signed by a VITAL teacher. See last page of application for this VITAL attendance form.

Application Deadline and Submission Instructions

- 1. *All scholarship materials* (application forms, letters, transcripts, attendance information) must be submitted together. *Incomplete applications* will *not* be *reviewed*.

- 3. Applications *must be received by 4:00 pm, Friday, March 31, 2017*.

Other Requirements

- 1. Students must have applied and been accepted for admission to their desired KCC program to be eligible.
- 2. The recipient must *enroll in at least nine (9) credit hours* as a Kirkwood student each semester.
- Recipients must write a thank you letter to the donor and submit it to Megan Burke-Brunscheen, Grant Wood AEA, AEGON/Transamerica Foundation Kirkwood Scholarship, 4401 6th Street SW, Cedar Rapids, IA 52404 by June 1, 2017.
- 4. Students may *not have received* an AEGON/Transamerica Foundation scholarship *in the past.*
