Scholarship Application Guidelines

The TrebleMakers are an active group of parents who support Monticello's vocal music programs by fundraising through various avenues. We support the programs by proving equipment, materials, and costuming that the school might not otherwise be able to provide. We also host a variety of vocal music events such as the Dessert Concert. We have been fortunate to provide monetary assistance to students attending the bi-annual concert choir trips as well as helping with costs associated with other traveling competitions and events.

The TrebleMakers are pleased to offer a scholarship opportunity of \$500 to qualified applicants according to the following guidelines:

- 1) The TrebleMakers Scholarship Application is available from the High School Guidance Office. This application must be completed, signed, and submitted to the Guidance Office (along with all necessary attachments and documents) by the April 10th deadline.
- 2) To qualify for the scholarship process, the student must meet the following criteria:
 - a) Cumulative high school GPA of 3.0
 - b) Been involved in high school choir 3 or the 4 years
 - c) Must be pursuing a music-related major in college
- 3) The \$500 scholarship, if awarded, will be paid directly to your college after you have successfully completed one semester. You must provide proof of completion of the semester with a minimum of 3.0 GPA by transcript or grade sheet, reflecting a vocal music-related major and showing vocal music class and/or participation in choir. This information should be submitted to the treasurer of TrebleMakers, along with the address of your college financial aid office and your student ID #.

Applications received in a timely fashion will be reviewed by the TrebleMakers board and a selection will be made by vote. The winner(s) will be announced at the Awards Ceremony.
