Additional information about the scholarship:

- 1. The scholarship selection is made by the Monticello Scholarship Committee.
- 2. The scholarship winner(s) will be selected based on educational achievements and goals. The recipient will exemplify strong, positive character and the promise for future success in their selected engineering or education field. Selection is not weighted to favor high academic achievement. However, a minimum grade point average of 2.0 is required.
- 3. Selection of the recipient will be made without discrimination as outlined in the Monticello Community School District Board policy and regardless of the applicant's relationship with the Monticello Scholarship Committee.
- 4. The recipient may attend a 2 or 4 year program at a college, university or technical school in an engineering or education field.
- 5. The scholarship proceeds will be paid to the recipient in two equal installments. The student must present school bill or enrollment form to the Monticello School District Foundation each semester to receive these payments.
- 6. The scholarship will lapse if the recipient fails to enroll at the beginning of the semester or fails to remain in school as outlined in paragraph 4 above.
- 7. If the recipient is not eligible to receive the award or does not make claim to the award at the beginning of the first semester following graduation, the award will be rescinded and no money will be given.
