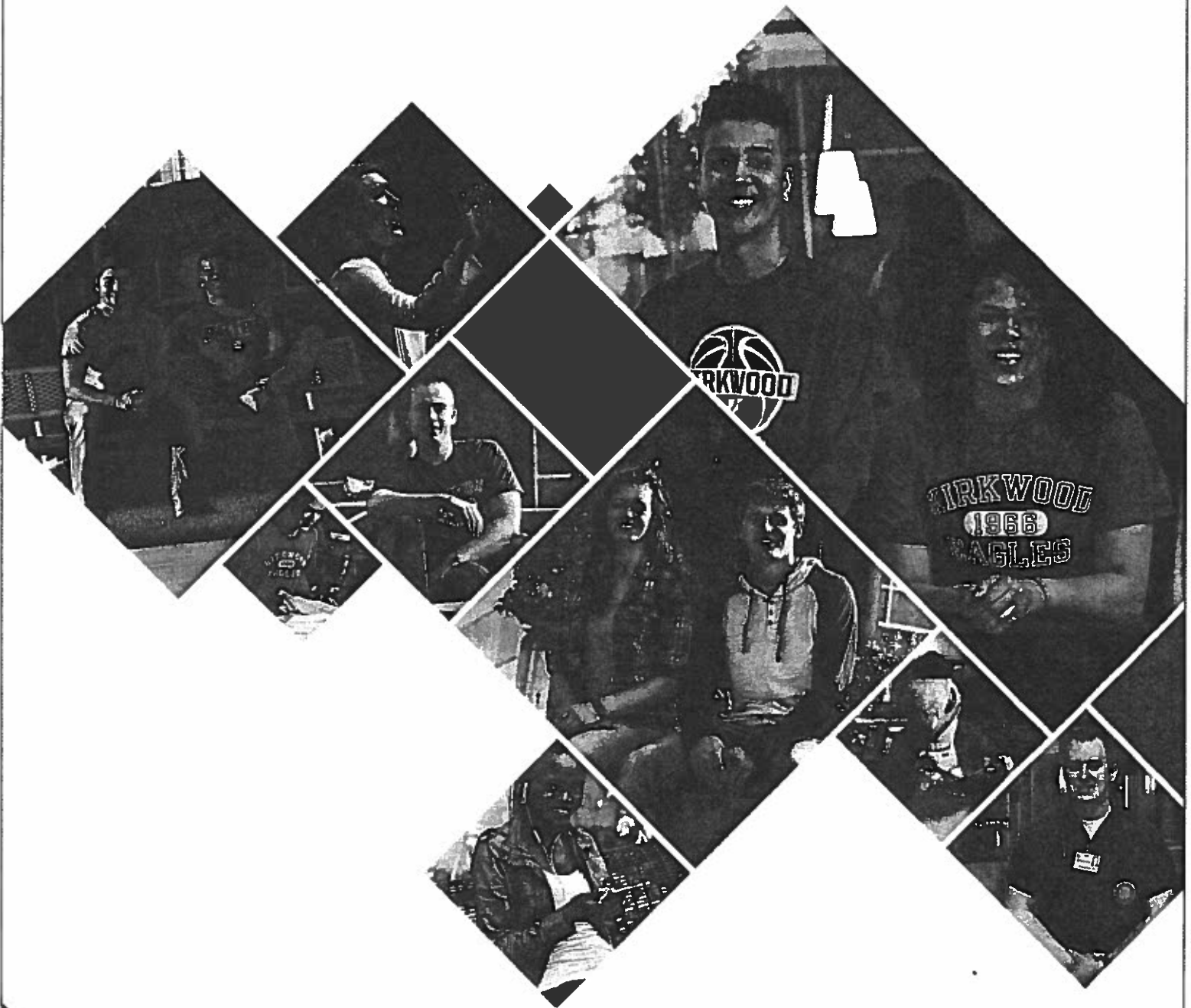

Leaders for Tomorrow Scholarship

The Leaders for Tomorrow scholarship is for high school seniors with a 3.0 GPA or higher (at the time of this application deadline) who are in the top half of their class.

Up to 100 scholarships for \$3,000 are awarded to seniors who will be full-time Kirkwood students in the fall following high school graduation and can demonstrate strong leadership qualities. This scholarship is awarded during students' first year. At least one community and two high school leadership experiences are required during the junior and/or senior years of high school.

Awarded: \$1,500 for fall
\$1,500 for spring

The Presidential Scholarship

High school seniors with an ACT test score of 25 or higher and 3.5 GPA or higher are eligible for Presidential scholarships. Up to 30 scholarships for \$5,000 each are available to students who meet this criteria and who will be full-time Kirkwood students in the fall and spring following high school graduation. This scholarship is awarded during students' first year.

Awarded: \$2,500 for fall
\$2,500 for spring

Presidential: **\$5,000**

Leaders for Tomorrow: **\$3,000**

APPLICATION PROCESS

The applicant must:

- Submit **this** paper scholarship application or submit an electronic application at www.kirkwood.edu/scholarships (available after October 1).
- Submit high school transcript **with this application**, regardless if you have previously sent a copy to Kirkwood.
- Obtain two original reference letters supporting the scholarship qualifications and accomplishments, and submit them **with this application** to:

Examples of acceptable references include: instructors, counselors, former and/or current employers, doctors and others in responsible positions who can objectively attest to your qualities and accomplishments. (Excludes relatives and close friends.)

- Essay questions **must** be a minimum of 1,000 words total combined.

DEADLINE

All applications must be postmarked or received in the Kirkwood Admissions office by **Friday, December 15, 2017** for first round, **Thursday, March 15, 2018** for second round.

NOTIFICATION

First-round scholarships will be awarded in December 2017 and all remaining scholarships will be awarded in Spring 2018.
