Policy Title: School District Bus Routes Policy #702.10

The superintendent, or designee, will determine the school bus routes for the school district. It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent, or designee, to develop the school bus routes keeping in mind the safety of the students, the size of the school buses, the length of the route, the cost to the school district, and other factors as deemed relevant by the board or the superintendent. The superintendent, or designee, shall also develop emergency school bus routes that may be necessary due to weather or other conditions.

The school district is required to provide a certain level of transportation service to its resident students. The board has complete discretion to provide additional transportation service to its resident and other students.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to make a recommendation as to whether a school vehicle will make a discretionary stop. In making this recommendation, the superintendent shall consider the safety of the students, the size of the school buses, the length of the route, the cost to the school district and other factors as deemed relevant by the board or the superintendent.
