



DuTrac's Academic Scholarship Program

DuTrac's Academic Scholarship Program is now available to graduating seniors who are members in good standing for at least one year with DuTrac. Up to seven (4 – \$500 and 3 – \$1,000) non-renewable scholarships will be awarded to qualified students who plan to attend an accredited community college, trade school, technical college or university.

There are two different options available to apply for this scholarship.

*Type and submit an essay, double-spaced, containing a minimum of 500 words, or

*Create a 60-90 second in length video on the following topic:

Lifestyle of celebrities or the wealthy are often portrayed in the media. If you could switch places with a celebrity or someone who is/was wealthy (living or no longer living), who would it be and describe your lifestyle as this person.

Please make sure to read rules and guidelines. Incomplete applications or information not submitted will be invalid and not included in the judging process.
