What do Clover Kids do?

- Investigate Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics (STEAM)
- Explore literacy through fun, engaging ways to read and write
- Learn the importance of being healthy and physically active
- Practice communication skills and learn to work as a team
- Make new friends
