

### **Content and Location of Records**

A student record may include but is not limited to the following types of records: identifying data; grades; academic work completed; scores on standardized intelligence and achievement tests; aptitude and interest inventory results, health data; family information; teacher or counselor ratings of observations; verified reports of serious or recurrent behavior patterns; reports, other documents and information related to special education evaluation and/or the provision of special education services. Only information related to the planning and provision of appropriate educational services may be generated and maintained as part of a student's record.

Student records are normally maintained at the school at which the student is enrolled and, as necessary at other facilities housing staff, programs, or services.
