

Successful education programs require the support of the community. The board recognizes this support is dependent on the community's understanding of and participation in the efforts, goals, and programs of the school district.

In striving to obtain the support of the community, the board will:

- Provide access to school district records;
- Inform the community of the school district's goals, objectives, achievements, and needs;
- Invite the input of the community; and,
- Encourage cooperation between the school district and the community as well as with agencies and organizations to best serve the welfare of its students.

It shall further be the policy of the board to actively cooperate with community agencies and organizations concerned with the welfare of students.

The superintendent shall be responsible for initiating and administering a continuous program of communication with the community. The superintendent shall utilize needed school district personnel and all media available in discharging this responsibility.
