

**Official Minutes of the Monticello Community School District
Board of Education Special Meeting of August 12, 2020**

The Board of Education Special Meeting was held in the Board Room at the High School at 850 East Oak Street, Monticello, Iowa on Wednesday, August 12, 2020. The Work Session was called to order at 6:04 pm by President John Schlarmann. Board member Craig Stadtmueller led the Pledge of Allegiance and read the Monticello CSD mission statement.
