



# The NHS Scholarship

Since 1946, more than \$15 million in scholarships has been awarded to outstanding NHS senior members. The scholarship program is supported by the parent organization of NHS, the National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP).

**Applications are now being accepted for the 2019–20 NHS Scholarship!**

## How to Apply

- Senior members of an active NHS chapter who are in good standing are eligible to apply for an NHS Scholarship.
- NHS Members must first [create a student account](#) before they can access the NHS Scholarship application.
- Their NHS adviser must verify the student's membership before the student can begin the application. **Applicants should not log into the application until the verification process is complete.**
- Verified NHS members may start [the NHS Scholarship application](#).
- All applications require two recommendations, and certification by the NHS adviser in order to be considered complete. Incomplete applications are not evaluated.

## Deadlines

### **11:59 pm PST on December 6, 2019**

The student portion of the application is due.

### **11:59 pm PST on December 10, 2019**

All recommendations (two) and adviser certification is due.

## 2019-2020 Award Distribution

- 1 National Winner – \$25,000 scholarship
- 24 national finalists – \$5,625 scholarship
- 575 national semifinalists – \$3,200 scholarship
- Total scholarships awarded: 600
- Total scholarship distribution: \$2 million
