Since 1946, more than \$15 million in scholarships has been awarded to outstanding NHS senior members. The scholarship program is supported by the parent organization of NHS, the National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP).

How to Apply

- Senior members of an active NHS chapter who are in good standing are eligible to apply for an NHS Scholarship.
- NHS Members must first <u>create a student account</u> before they can access the NHS Scholarship application.
- Their NHS adviser must verify the student's membership before the student can begin the application. **Applicants should not log into the application until the verification process is complete.**
- Verified NHS members may start the NHS Scholarship application.
- All applications require two recommendations, and certification by the NHS adviser in order to be considered complete. Incomplete applications are not evaluated.

Deadlines

The student portion of the application is due.

11:59 pm PST on December 10, 2019

All recommendations (two) and adviser certification is due.
