GUIDELINES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE 1) ROTARY/I. DALE GREENAWALD SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND 2) THE ROTARY BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP

A. Selection Committee

The selection committee will consist of three Rotarians appointed by the current Rotary president and they may call of the high school counselor, business instructors, a vocal instructor and/or instrumental instructor from Monticello School District.

B. Application Procedures

The High School Counseling Office will distribute application forms and submit the materials to the selection committee. Student will only receive one scholarship and should not apply for both.

Applicants will be required to provide the Monticello High School Counseling Office with:

- 1. A complete application form (attached)
- 2. Three letters of reference from teachers, employers, minister, etc.

C. Criteria For Selection

- 1 a. Greenawald Scholarship Musical interest and talent. (Note: any Monticello senior is eligible for the scholarship, however, preference shall be given to students planning to attend an accredited college or university and majoring in a music program.)
- b. Business Scholarship Students must be planning on attending an accredited college or university and majoring in business.
- 2. Past Academic Achievement
- 3. Citizenship
- 4. Financial Need
- 5. Predictability of Success
- 6. Character

D. Scholarship Winner Announced

To be made at the Honors Night Program at Monticello High School each spring.

E. Amount of Scholarship

Greenwald Scholarship: 1-\$500 Scholarship for music.

Business Scholarship: 1-\$1,000 Scholarship for further education and can be used for a 2 year, 4 year or vocational schooling with the emphasis on business.

If no suitable applicants are available in either or both categories, no scholarship will be awarded for that category.

F. Payment of Scholarship

The scholarship winner will contact the treasurer of the Monticello Rotary after their first semester of school and provide a grade report showing satisfactory progress (C average or better). A check for the scholarship amount payable to the student will be issued. If the student withdraws from school, any unused scholarship money will be returned to the Rotary/L. Dale Greenawald Scholarship Fund, c/o treasurer of the Monticello Rotary.
