

## Joe Halbur Scholarship

The Iowa Association of Naturalists – Joe Halbur Scholarship Fund is offering a \$1,000 scholarship to students who plan to further their education in the degrees of environmental education, cultural interpretation, historical interpretation or outdoor recreation.

- Applicant must be a resident of Iowa at time of graduation from high school, and preference may be given to attendance at an in-state college.
- Applicant must be pursuing a degree in natural resources. Preference will be given to those pursuing a degree in environmental education, cultural interpretation, historical interpretation or outdoor recreation.
- Applicant may reapply throughout their undergraduate program and scholarships may be renewed. Same form must be filled out each year for reapplication.
- Scholarship payments will be made directly to the college or university, upon receipt of an e-mail letter from the recipient to the Joe Halbur Scholarship Chair of the Iowa Association of Naturalists.
- Applications must be received by March 4, 2022.
- Announcement of the recipient will be made by April 4, 2022.

The award winner is encouraged to attend the Fall IAN Workshop. IAN will provide an additional scholarship of \$150 to cover travel, lodging, membership and workshop costs. The 2022 Fall workshop is in Muscatine County.


