

Preschool Scholarship Program Information & Application 2022-2023

Thank you for your interest in our Preschool Scholarship Program. State tax dollars are allocated to Cedar and Jones counties through Cedar/Jones Early Childhood Iowa to help support children and their families when they choose high quality early education for their child. Scholarships allow for access to financial assistance to help offset costs associated with early preschool education.

To apply for a Preschool Scholarship, complete the attached 2022-2023 application and send the application and <u>a most recent copy of Federal Income Tax Returns for all individuals supporting the household</u> to the Preschool Scholarship Manager. Only the current application completed in its entirety will be accepted.

Eligibility Criteria:

Your child will be 3, 4, or 5 years of age as of September 15th, 2022.

Your child lives in Cedar or Jones County or within the boundaries of the Anamosa, Bennett, Durant, Midland, Monticello, North Cedar, Olin, Tipton, and West Branch School Districts.

<u>Children living outside of Cedar or Jones County must first apply for a preschool scholarship from the county of residence before determination will be made.</u>

Your child attends or will attend a high-quality participating preschool.

Your family meets income guidelines. Please note that this is gross annual income and includes salary/wages/stipends, unemployment benefits, SSI, FIP, Social Security, Child Support, Veteran's benefits, and direct student loans.

Your child is in Foster Care warranted through the Iowa Department of Human Services.

Scholarships will only be paid to preschools within Cedar and Jones counties meeting program guidelines. The Cedar/Jones Early Childhood Iowa Board will review exception requests to Preschool Scholarship policies upon individual requests.

If your child is awarded a scholarship, payment will be made directly to the preschool. <u>A copayment may be required by the preschool and will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian</u>.

Preschool attendance will be monitored by the school and reported to the Preschool Scholarship Program Manager monthly. At least 85% attendance will be required for participation in the scholarship program. If the child is sick and misses school, these days will not be included in the 85% attendance requirement if a written doctor's excuse is provided.

If attendance falls below 85%, one warning will be given to parents by program management. The second time attendance falls below 85%, the child may be terminated from the scholarship program and not be allowed to re-enter during the current school year. Full preschool tuition will then be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Families receiving a Preschool Scholarship will be required to complete Ages & Stages Developmental and Social/Emotional Screenings for their child. Further information will be shared after preschool has started.

Applications for Preschool Scholarships will not be considered until a completed application and most recent copies of Federal Income Tax Returns for all individuals supporting the household income has been received.

For your information -- The following programs use the Federal Poverty Guidelines:

100% - Head Start; Early Head Start

130% - Shared Visions Preschool; National School Lunch Program (Free - at or below 130%); Medicaid (133%)

145% - State Child Care Assistance

150% - Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LiHEAP); Weatherization

185% - WIC; Title V - Maternal & Child Health Services.

National School Lunch Program (Reduced fees - between 130% - 185%)

200% - ECI Low-Income Preschool Tuition Assistance; Hawk-i;

*Children at or below 100% of poverty could be eligible for Head Start and need to contact the Head Start Center nearest to their home. Preschool Scholarship funds are to avoid duplication of services and funds with other preschool programming including Head Start.
