

Foreign students must meet all district entrance requirements including age, place of residence, and immunization to be enrolled in the district. Students who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents of the district if the student resides with a “host family” within the boundaries of the district and the student is in the United States with appropriate documentation.

In addition, foreign students must meet one (1) of the following requirements:

1. The student is a participant in a recognized foreign exchange program; or
2. The student is physically able to attend school and has provided the district with such proof, including a current TB test.

The superintendent must approve foreign students for enrollment. The board reserves the right to limit the number of foreign students accepted for enrollment.
