3) Feel your breath

Follow the sensation of your breath as it goes in and as it goes out.

4) Notice when your mind has wandered

Your attention will leave the breath and wander to other places. When you get around to noticing that your mind has wandered—in a few seconds, or even one minute simply return your attention to the breath.

5) Be kind to your wandering mind

Don't judge yourself or obsess over the content of the thoughts you find yourself lost in. Just come back.

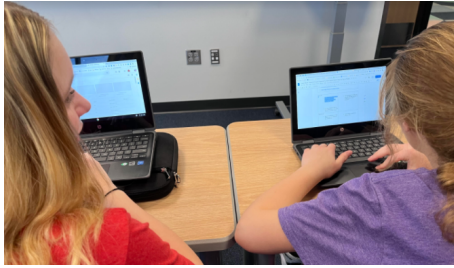
Student Creation
