As UD for Kids enters its 30th year, I am excited to send you information about the University of Dubuque's summer program for students.

- **All students who have completed grades 1-7 and have interest in participating are eligible to attend.**
- A variety of courses are offered to build reading and math skills in the areas of science, math, engineering, visual and performing arts, aviation, and culinary arts.
- Appropriate precautionary measures for COVID19 may be implemented during the weeks of class. These may include:
 - wearing masks while indoors,
 - encouraging hand washing and use of hand sanitizer,
 - social distancing,
 - capping class size at 16 students or less,
 - restricting contact among students to those in their selected classes
- The fee for the program is \$125.00 per session. This includes all class materials, a daily snack, and a UD for Kids t-shirt.
- To participate parents must complete an application form by 6:00 p.m. on **April 8**. The link for this form can be found on the UD for Kids website, <http://www.dbq.edu/udforkids>.
- Class selection and payment of the required fee will occur on registration day, **April 9**. Instructions for class selection and fee payment will be on the UD for Kids website.
- Updates and information will be posted on the UD for Kids website in the coming weeks. Please monitor regularly to stay current.

The 2022 dates for UD for Kids are:

- Session one - June 20-24, for **current** first & second graders;
- Session two - June 27-July 1, for **current** third & fourth graders;
- Session three - July 11-15, for **current** fifth, sixth & seventh graders.

Students in sessions 1 and 2 will select two classes from a variety of choices. Students in session 3 will select one class. Classes are held from 12:30-4:00 p.m. on the University of Dubuque campus, unless otherwise designated in the class description.

Some classes for 5th-7th grade students do run during the first and second sessions. These classes, and all others for this age group are listed under session 3 classes, July 11-15. If class dates are different from July 11-15 it will be clearly stated in the class description.

Join us in our 30th year of enrichment for tri-state students. We look forward to seeing you on the beautiful University of Dubuque campus this summer!
