

SAFE SLEEP TRAININGS



According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, approximately 3,400 infants die every year from sleep-related deaths. Theo Benjamin Wolf was a happy and healthy 12-week-old infant who tragically died as a result of unsafe sleep practices. The Theo Wolf Foundation was established in March 2021 with a mission to promote and educate the public on infant safe sleep.

Lisa Wolf, Founder and President of the Theo Wolf Foundation, will share their personal story of losing their son, Theo, in 2019. Lisa will educate parents, grandparents, and childcare providers on what safe sleep is. She will focus on the ABCs of safe sleep, discuss popular products on the market that are not safe for sleep, and discuss recommendations for safe sleep for every child, ensuring "Safe Sleep, Every Sleep."
