

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT US:

- Our average ACT score is 21.8.
- Our graduation rate is 97%.
- Built new middle school and renovated High School entrance and District Office in July 2020.
- Of our graduates, 36% of our students go on to attend a 2-year college; 38% to a 4-year college; 4% enroll in the military; and 22% enter the workforce.
- We are a 1:1 technology district—each student PreK-2 uses an iPad, and grades 3-12 receive a Chromebook. Students in grades 7-12 are allowed to take their Chromebook home each night.
- 4-year-old Preschool program with class sizes limited to 14.
- Approximately 90% of our students participate in extra-curricular activities. We offer a wide variety of extra-curricular activities including: band, basketball, bowling, cheerleading, choir, cross country, dance, drama, football, track, speech, volleyball, and wrestling.
- About 100 high school students (mostly juniors & seniors) take at least one college class each year. Most earn an average of 30 college credits before graduation, some 40+.
- Develops young leaders through Student Council and National Honor Society.
- We are continuously updating our facilities.
- Low staff turnover rate.
- Our Standards Referenced Reporting (SRR) grading system focuses on what students know and are able to do. Teachers teach, assess, and provide constant feedback to students on where they are currently in their learning, where they need to go to meet each standard, and how they will reach each standard.
- We work hand in hand with our Board, staff, and community to develop a Strategic Operating Plan (SOP).
- Our Elementary Counselor was named Iowa Elementary Counselor of the Year in 2019 and Iowa Counselor of the Year in 2020.
- We've had several conference championships in basketball, volleyball, girls golf, and recent state appearances in bowling, cross country, girls and boys basketball, wrestling, track, and football.
- Monticello High School and Middle School have both been recognized as a Banner School for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) by the Department of Education.
