Students who become ill or are injured at school will be given first aid if possible. The district will attempt to notify the student's parents by phone as soon as possible and instructions will be requested as to the disposition of the situation. In most instances, an ill or injured child will be turned over to the care of the parents. When a parent cannot be reached in an emergency, the student shall be transported to the doctor's office or hospital by an ambulance or a school vehicle. The board assumes no responsibility for medical treatment of students.

In cases of emergency, the method of transportation will be determined based upon a review of the relevant facts and circumstances, and may ultimately require ambulance transportation. The Emergency Card file will be used to determine physician and hospital designated by the parent.

It is the responsibility of the principal to file an accident report with the superintendent within twenty-four (24) hours after a student is injured.
