# ONLINE REGISTRATION

Registration for the Monticello Community School District for the 2025-26 school year will be done ONLINE ONLY again this year. All families are required to register their students in their Infinite Campus account through the process known as Online Registration (OLR). Online registration (OLR) will open on August 4! OLR allows parents to register at their own convenience and to save time for future years.

**RETURNING Students** - Login to the Infinite Campus Parent Portal and complete the 25-26 registration. If you do not know your login, please email morgan.murray@monticello. k12.ia.us.

- · Little Panthers Preschool parents that received letters of acceptance will also need to do online registration.
- · Online registration needs to be done by August 15. If you are unable to register online, please contact your building secretary (after August 1) to set up a time to register before August 15. Support for online registration will NOT be available at Open House.
- · You are able to pay online for fees and lunch once you are logged in. You can pay by credit or debit card (a convenience fee of 3.61% will be charged), or by e-check (a convenience fee of only 35 cents will be charged). During the week of August 4-8, the convenience fees will be waived. If you don't wish to pay online, payment can be mailed or made at your school building.
- Schedules, padlocks, Chromebooks, etc. can be picked up at open house once fees have been paid.
  - All school offices are back open on Aug. 1.
- Please check our website and Facebook page regularly for updates as well.

## **Physical Exams**

All students in grades 7 through 12 must have a physical examination before they can participate in any sport. Practice for high school football, cross country and volleyball begins on August 11. Participants must have their physicals and HEADS UP: Concussion in High School Sports form completed before they engage in practice.

#### Inclement Weather

Whenever it is necessary to make changes to the school schedule (cancellations, late starts, etc.) due to inclement weather, we will be using the districts notification system, School Messenger, to notify parents with emails, text messages and automated phone calls. This again emphasizes the importance of having up-to-date contact information in Infinite Campus. Also, an announcement will be made on or before the 6:00 a.m. broadcast on local radio and television stations. If it is necessary to call off school during the school day, an announcement will be made over the same stations.
