Hi everyone,

Take a look at this rendering of the front of the new elementary school! It really has some nice curb appeal! We have been working for several months to do the planning on the new elementary school and we are rapidly coming to an end on that

phase of the project. The architects and engineers are finalizing several details and the project plans will be ready for the school



board to consider approval of going out to bid at the September 22 board meeting. Then from September 23-October 23 contractors will prepare their bids to be opened publicly on October 23. Finally, on October 27, at the school board meeting, the school board will consider approval of the contractor for this project.

We started the pre-planning on this project in January of 2024 to better understand the financials, our bonding capacity, and the cost of a new building. The school board mobilized an Elementary School Project Committee that worked together during the spring of 2024 to explore the option of a new elementary school. With committee support, the school board called for a school district General Obligation Bond election in November of 2024. With the community support for a General Obligation Bond which passed with 60.5% of the community supporting this project. Following that we started the planning process which brings us up to today.

If a contractor is approved in October at the school board meeting, the ground will be broken this fall, the contractor will mobilize for the project, and the construction will begin. If everything goes as scheduled the new elementary school should be completed in March of 2027. That means this project from the very beginning stages to the end will have taken over three years to complete. That seems like a long time but the final product will be worth it. This school building will be an incredible addition to our community.




