



**Preschool Scholarship Program

Thank you for your interest in our Preschool Scholarship Program. State tax dollars are allocated to Cedar and Jones counties through Cedar/Jones Early Childhood Iowa to help support children and their families when they choose high quality early education for their child. Scholarships allow access to financial assistance to help offset costs associated with preschool education.

ELIGIBILITY (check all that apply):

- ☐ Child will be 3, 4, or 5 years of age as of September 15th, 2025 and not entering Kindergarten.
- ☐ Child lives in Cedar or Jones County.
- ☐ Child is not eligible for other funding for this service (i.e. State Child Care Assistance, Promise Jobs, Head Start).
- ☐ Child attends or will attend a high-quality participating preschool.
- ☐ Family meets income guidelines of 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. Please note that this is gross annual income and includes salary/wages/stipends, unemployment benefits, SSI, FIP, Social Security, Child Support, Veteran's benefits, and direct student loans.
- ☐ Child is in Foster Care warranted through the Iowa Dept of Health and Human Services.
- ☐ You agree to completed Ages and Stages Screenings on your child.

FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY :

The following table outlines 2025 Federal Poverty Guidelines. Requirements for Preschool Scholarships are for eligible children whose families are 200% or below Federal Poverty Guidelines. Family income will be verified through the submittal of the first 2 pages of Federal Income Tax Returns for all household wage earners.

****Children at or below 100% of poverty could be eligible for Head Start and need to contact the Head Start Center nearest to their home. Preschool Scholarship funds are to avoid duplication of services and funds with other preschool programming including Head Start.***

PAYMENT: If your child is awarded a scholarship, payment will be made directly to the preschool. Scholarships will only be paid to preschools within Cedar and Jones counties meeting program guidelines. Parents/guardians will be notified in writing the term and monthly amount of the scholarship. No payment will be made to parents/guardians.

A co-payment may be required by the preschool and will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Parents/guardians are responsible for any late fees, late pick-up charges, transportation fees, activity fees, or registration fees.

Parent/guardian understands a referral may be made to an investigative unit when fraudulent practices are suspected. Parent/guardian understands that repayment of scholarship benefits may be necessary if a scholarship was received in error, because of misrepresentation of any information, or fraudulent billing.

SCREENINGS: Parents/guardians will be required to complete Ages & Stages Developmental and Social/Emotional Screenings for their child. By submitting this application, you are agreeing to complete two different screenings for your child. The screening tools will be sent out with scholarship award letters and need to be returned prior to receiving a scholarship.

The Ages and Stages Questionnaire-3 addresses your child's development including areas of communication, gross motor, fine motor, problem solving, and personal social skills. You will be asked questions about some things your child can and cannot do.

The Ages and Stages Questionnaire – Social/Emotional-2 addresses social-emotional development. Social-emotional development within the first few years of life prepares your child to be confident, trusting, curious, and able to develop positive relationships with others. A child's positive social-emotional development forms a foundation for learning throughout life.

ATTENDANCE: Preschool attendance will be monitored by the school and reported to the Preschool Scholarship Program Manager monthly. At least 85% attendance will be required for participation in the scholarship program. If the child is sick and misses school, these days will not be included in the 85% attendance requirement if a written doctor's excuse is provided.

If attendance falls below 85%, one warning will be given to parents by program management. The second time attendance falls below 85%, the child may be terminated from the scholarship program and not be allowed to re-enter during the current school year. Full preschool tuition will then be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

I will notify Cedar/Jones Early Childhood Iowa if the child's eligibility changes and/or the child becomes eligible for other sources of funding such as State Child Care Assistance, Early Childhood Special Education, Head Start, and/or others. If the preschool program the child is attending is eligible to accept State Child Care Assistance, I agree to apply for State Child Care Assistance and provide Cedar/Jones Early Childhood Iowa a copy of the CCA decision upon receipt of notification.

Scholarships will end before the termination date if the family no longer meets eligibility requirements or fails to provide updated information.

Applications for Preschool Scholarships will not be considered until a completed application and most recent copies of Federal Income Tax Returns for all individuals supporting the household income have been received.

If a Federal Income Tax Return is not available, documentation will be required for all forms of income. Please contact the Preschool Scholarship Program Manager for further information.
