SMS Communications

Monticello Community School District uses SMS text messaging to facilitate communications between District personnel and parents, guardians, students, employees, vendors, and community members regarding educational, operational, administrative, and customer-service matters.

SMS communications may include, but are not limited to:

- Attendance-related communications
- Scheduling and appointment coordination
- Transportation communications
- Student support and student services communications
- Health office communications
- Administrative matters
- Facilities and operations coordination
- Vendor and contractor communications
- Responses to inquiries submitted to the District
- Other District-related business communications

The District does not use SMS messaging for advertising, marketing, or promotional purposes. **Consent to Receive Messages**

By providing a mobile telephone number to the District, requesting SMS communication, initiating a text conversation with a District telephone number, or otherwise consenting to receive text messages, you agree to receive SMS communications related to District business.

Recipients may receive SMS communications because:

- They provided a telephone number to the District through student registration, employment records, forms, service requests, or other District processes;
- They requested communication by text message;
- They initiated communication with a District telephone number; or
- An existing communication relationship exists with the District.

Message Frequency

Message frequency varies and depends on the nature of the communication and the recipient's interactions with the District.

Message and Data Rates

Message and data rates may apply. Charges are determined by the recipient's wireless carrier

and service plan.

Opt-Out Instructions

Recipients may opt out of SMS communications at any time by replying STOP to any District text message.

Following an opt-out request, the recipient may receive a final confirmation message indicating that SMS communications have been discontinued.

Help and Support

Recipients may obtain assistance by replying HELP to any District SMS message or by contacting the District directly.
